

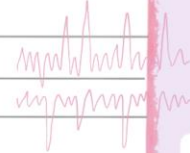

## Intermittent Auscultation

- Care by J.Banks (RM). Introductions made.
- **Indication** - Antenatal Appt, Labour Care etc.
  - **Low Risk** Indications
  - **Informed Consent** - Given/Declined
  - Type of **Device** used - Doppler/Pinard
  - **Length** of FH Auscultation - Seconds/Minutes
  - Record **Fetal Heart Rate (FHR)** as a single number (bpm)
  - Record FHR in all **Notes** and **Partogram** (if in labour)
  - Record **Maternal/Parental** Heart Rate
  - Record any **Similarity** or **Difference** between FHR and Maternal Heart Rate
  - Record presence or absence of **Accelerations**
  - Record presence or absence of **Decelerations**
  - Record presence of **Fetal Movements**
  - Record **Uterine Activity** Pattern
  - Record any **Response** to changes - Rupture of membranes, Vaginal Examination etc.
  - Are there any **Indications** for **Continuous Electronic Fetal Monitoring (CEFM)**. JBanks(RM)
