## Worksheet - Bones 1

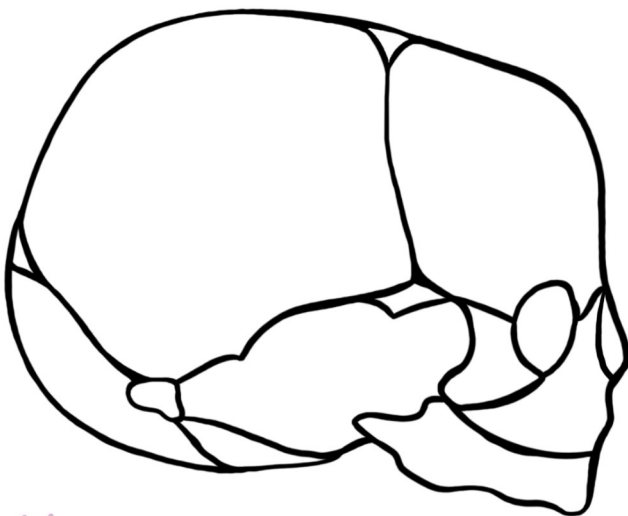
The 1 is made up of several major 2 that are connected together.

In a newborn skull there is how many of each bone?

- 3 Frontal Bone(s)
- 4 Parietal Bone(s)
- 5 Occipital Bone(s)
- 6 Temporal Bone(s)
- 7 Sphenoid Bone(s)
- 8 Mandible(s)
- 9 Maxilla

The p12 bones lie on either side of the skull and occupy most of the skull area.

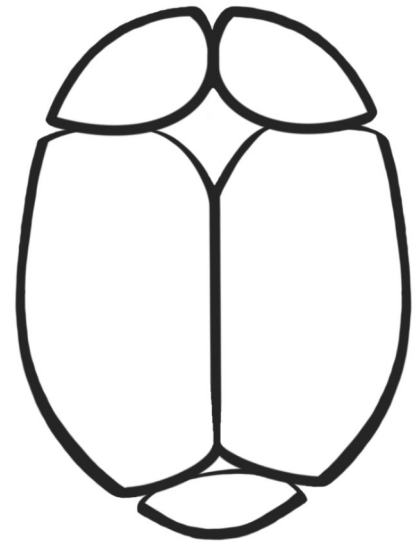
The sp13 is a single bone located in front of the occipital bone on each side.



The o16 bone forms the back of the skull.

The 17 forms the upper jaw.

The f10 starts as 11 bones which fuse into a single bone after the age of eight years old.



The 14 lie closest to the ear on each side of the head.

The 15 is the largest and strongest bone in the face, forming the jaw and mouth
